## Since 2010:

Generally, all age groups experienced a decline in the percent uninsured for both the county and state.

The 18-64 year age group experienced the greatest decline in number of people uninsured under the ACA.

## SUMMARY OF ADDITIONAL SOCIODEMOGRAPHIC FACTORS

Uninsured status was highest among adults (25 years and older) with less than high school education; however, this group saw the largest drop in uninsured status overall between 2012-2015 (16.5\% points)

Particularly high among communities in Northern San Diego (Anza-Borrego Springs and San Marcos; 55.1\% and 54.0\% respectively) in 2011-15

Adults working part-time had a higher percentage of uninsured, when compared to full-time or adults who did not work, at 15.2\% in 2015.

Highest in Palomar-Julian
(46.0\%) and National City
(43.8\%) in 2011-15

Unemployed adults(18+ years) had the largest percentage of uninsured adults at $21.3 \%$ in 2015 compared to employed adults and those not in the labor force.
> Valley Center and National City had the highest percentage (54.4\% and 54.8\% respectively) in 20112015

Households with incomes between \$25,000 and under \$50,000 had the largest percentage of uninsured at $14.0 \%$ in 2015.

Especially high in National City and Central San Diego; $33.3 \%$ and $31.0 \%$, respectively in 2011-15

# SUMMARY: IMPACTS OF THE ACA IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY 

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Groups with the largest decreases in the uninsured in 2015 were:
$\checkmark$ Unemployed (-24.8\%)
$\checkmark$ Adults with less than high school graduation (- 16.5\%)
$\checkmark$ Hispanics (-14.7\%)
$\checkmark$ Foreign born non-citizens (- 14.1\%)
$\checkmark$ Households making <\$25K (-12.9\%)
$\checkmark$ Adults ages $18-64$ years (-11.3\%)

Who Were More Likely to Remain Uninsured in San Diego County?
$\times$ Foreign born non-citizens (29\%)
$x$ Adults < HS Graduation (23.6\%)
x Unemployed (21.3\%)
x Individuals below 138\% of FPL(16\%)
$\times$ Adults 25-34 year olds (15.4\%)
$\times$ American Indian/Alaska Native (21.7\%) and Hispanics (15.3\%)
x Part-time workers (15.2\%)
x Household making \$25K-\$49.9k (14\%)
